Sunday, January 22nd

Sermon Notes:

Read James 5:13-18. James has a lot of confidence in the power of healing prayer. Do you share his confidence? What do you expect to happen when you or someone else prays for healing? Talk with God about your expectations.

Prayer focus: Pray that God would work in our church to bring healing to those who are sick or injured.

Monday, January 23rd

Read Mark 2:1-12. Jesus first offers spiritual healing and then offers physical healing as a sign proving the spiritual healing. How do you see physical healing as a sign for God's people today?

Prayer focus: Pray for Pastor Andrew and his family, that they would be vessels and recipients of God's healing work.

Thursday, January 26th

Read Luke 10:1-12; 17-20. Jesus sends the 70 to heal, and they return with "joy" and celebrate with Jesus. How do you feel when God works through you? Are you willing to step out in faith to see it happen? *Prayer focus: Pray for Charis Storms that she would be led by the Spirit to step out in faith to touch lives in Mongolia.*

Tuesday, January 24th

Read 2 Kings 20:1-6. How do Hezekiah's prayers impact the outcome of this situation? What do we learn about the power of praying for healing from this passage?

Prayer focus: Pray for church plants, Journey UMC and the Stand UMC, that they would be dedicated to prayer in all they do.

Friday, January 27th

Read Matthew 8:5-17 and Mark 9:14-29. How does faith fit into each of these healings? What role do you see faith having in praying for healing? How much faith do you have in God's desire to heal? *Prayer focus: Pray for the people of Syria as the country continues in a time of unrest as the government arrests and kills protestors.*

Wednesday, January 25th

Read Matthew 10:1-15. Jesus sent the disciples out with a mission that included "healing the sick." Is healing the sick part of your mission? How do you do it?

Prayer focus: Pray for the millions of child slaves working in the sex industries and agriculture.

Saturday, January 28th

Read Mark 3:1-6. Mark gives us a window into Jesus' emotions in this passage. What do we learn about Jesus' heart for those who are in need of healing?

Prayer focus: Pray that the people of Algeria, Libya, Morocco, Tunisia, and Western Sahara, that they might know the healing power of God.
