Sermon Notes:

you? Are you being a good steward of these resources?

Read Luke 19:1-10. Zacchaeus is one of two people whom Jesus says are "saved" in the Gospels. Zacchaeus' salvation is clear because he	
sets aside his former god (money) to follow Jesus. What actions have you taken to show that Jesus and not money is lord of your life?	
Tuesday, February 1st	
Read Luke 18:18-30. The rich ruler was able to follow all of the	
commandments except for the commandments that related to money.	
Why do you think that the issue of money was such a stumbling block for him? How is money a stumbling block for you?	
Wednesday, February 2nd	
Read Matthew 6:24. Every person has someone or something they	
serve. What does it look like when money is master? How would someone whose master is God handle money? Think about times when	
money has been your master. How can you put God first?	

Thursday, February 3rd

Read Psalm 24:1-2. Do you see everything in your life as being God's possessions that God has entrusted to you? Why or why not? What
would your life be like if you treated everything around you as God's?
Friday, February 4th
Read Ephesians 5:5. Paul equates greed with idolatry. How is greed he same as idolatry? Where do you see greed in your life? Ask God to nelp you remove that idol!
Saturday, February 5th
Read Luke 15:11-32. In what ways are you like the younger son who spends everything that the father gives him on his pleasures? Take time o follow this son's lead and come to God in repentance.
Sunday, February 6th

As we gather for worship, prepare your heart by focusing on God and offering this prayer: "Living God, as we gather to worship you today, help me to encounter you, to truly worship you, to hear from you and to have my life changed by you. In Jesus' name, Amen."
