-For the people of Haiti, that they might receive the assistance they need in order to rebuild their lives

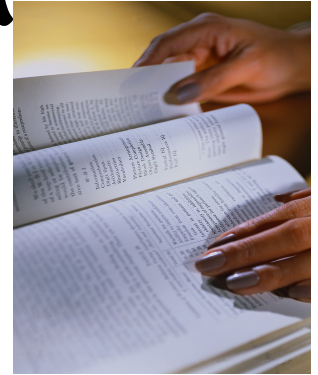
-For Charis Storms and the people of Mongolia

Transformation Journal

February 21st, 2010



Inviting you to daily time with God.

Each day the Transformation Journal will offer you a scripture passage and a question or two for reflection. Take a few minutes each day, and see what God has for you! The prayer list is also on the back, so please take time to pray for those we have lifted up on Sunday.

Sunday, February 21st

Sermon Notes:

Read 1 Thessalonians 1:2-8. Think back over the past two months and all we have discussed about our labor of love, then think about what you wrote and discussed today regarding how you believe God is calling us. What do you believe is our labor of love?

Monday, February 22nd

Read Acts 13:1-3. The church at Antioch heard God’s call and immediately acted to follow after God. Do we have this level of commitment as a church? What will help us as a church and as individuals to embrace God’s call and follow?

Tuesday, February 23rd

Read Exodus 3:16-4:17. How did God respond to most of Moses’ questions? Why does God eventually get angry with Moses? What questions do you have for God about our calling as a church and your calling individually?

Wednesday, February 24th

Read Jeremiah 1:4-10. God answers Jeremiah’s potential objection to God’s call before Jeremiah even speaks. How does God’s response prepare Jeremiah for his ministry? How does God’s response to Jeremiah speak to you as you consider God’s call upon us?

Thursday, February 25th

Read Isaiah 6:1-8. Once God acted to cleanse Isaiah of his sin, Isaiah was eager to be sent out by God. Are you eager to follow God’s call? Why or why not? Pray for God to give us excitement as a church.

Friday, February 26th

Read Judges 4:1-10. Compare Barak and Deborah. Why did Barak miss out on the glory that God was going to give him? What can we learn from these two leaders about following God?

Saturday, February 27th

Read Esther 4. Esther’s call was not a divine voice, but instead someone speaking to her and showing her God’s path for her life. How have other people spoken God’s call to you? Have you listened?

Sunday, February 28th

As you get ready for worship today, take time to prepare your heart to see God. Offer this prayer: **“Living God, as we gather to worship you today, help me to encounter you, to truly worship you, to hear from you and to have my life changed by you. In Jesus’ name, Amen.”**
