Sermon Notes:

Every day the Transformation Journal will offer you a scripture passage and a question or two for reflection. Take a few minutes each day, and see what God has for you! The prayer list is also on the back, so please take time to pray for those we have lifted up on Sunday.

Read Mark 11:1-11. How do you feel about the celebration of the crowd as you think about the way the crowd will respond to Jesus in the days to come? Are you ever tempted to praise Jesus when the crowd is praising but turn away from him when the crowd turns? Prayer focus: Pray that God would work in our church so that we would follow after Jesus both when it is popular and when it is hard.

Monday, April 2nd Read Isaiah 50:4-9. These words were written many years before Jesus' birth. Imagine reading these words and not knowing about Jesus. How would you feel about the person Isaiah is telling about? Prayer focus: Pray for Pastor Andrew and his family, that they would put God's plans and priorities first in their lives.	Thursday, April 5th Read Mark 14:26-72. Envision the story as Mark tells it. Where are you as the events unfold? How do you respond? Do you think you could have done better than Peter? Prayer focus: Pray for Charis Storms that she would encounter Jesus afresh this Lenten season.
Tuesday, April 3rd Read Philippians 2:5-11. Read through this passage a few times. What would it take for you to have the same mind in you that was in Jesus Christ? Prayer focus: Pray for church plants, Journey UMC and the Stand UMC, that they would draw near to their suffering Savior.	Friday, April 6th Read Mark 15:1-37. How do you feel as you read through this story? How do you think God the Father felt as he watched on without intervening? Prayer focus: Pray for the people of Syria as the country continues in time of unrest and the government arrests and kills protestors.
Wednesday, April 4th Read Mark 14:1-25. Talk to God about what it means to eat the body of Christ and drink the blood of Christ. How are you able to encounter Christ at the communion table? Prayer focus: Pray for the United Methodist General Conference that every delegate would be able to hear from God and encounter God.	Saturday, April 7th Read Mark 15:38-47. Put yourself into the story and try to experience the grief of those who did not know that Jesus would be resurrected. How do you feel? Thank God that we know Sunday is coming! Prayer focus: Pray for the people of Brunei, Malaysia, and Singapore that they would encounter the risen Christ.
