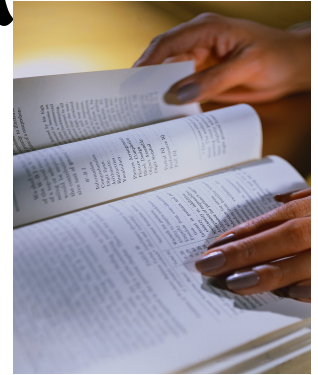
### Prayers for the church, nation, and world:

### **Sunday, April 4th**

Sermon Notes:

Do you treat Jesus like a dead leader or a Living Lord?

- Do you believe that all of his words are filled with God's wisdom or do you pick and choose what you like from his words?
- Do you have a relationship with your living Lord or just remember what he taught like a dead leader?
- Do you follow Jesus himself or simply follow his ideas?

Read Luke 24:1-12. Think about the angels' question: "Why do you look for the living among the dead?" Do you relate to Jesus like he is your living Lord? If so, how do you treat Jesus like he is alive? How is this different from how you treat leaders that you respect who are dead?

**Monday, April 5th**

Read John 20:1-18. Jesus made himself known to Mary by speaking her name. Are there times in your life when you have a hard time seeing God around you? How has Jesus made himself known to you? Listen to hear God call your name!

Read Luke 24:13-35. Put yourself in the place of these disciples at the beginning of the journey. How do you feel? Then imagine having your eyes opened to see Jesus through the breaking of the bread. What has God shown you through the breaking of the bread?

**Wednesday, April 7th**

Read 1 Corinthians 15:12-28. In this passage, Paul goes to great lengths to show that Jesus is truly raised from the dead. Examine your own heart: do you truly believe that Christ is risen? Do you believe that Christ's resurrection gives us hope for our own resurrection?

**Thursday, April 8th**

Read Acts 10:34-43. In this summary of Jesus' ministry, Peter puts the emphasis on Jesus' resurrection. Why was the resurrection so important for Peter? Is the resurrection this important to you?

**Friday, April 9th**

Read Acts 2:23-36. Peter tells the crowd that it was impossible for death to keep its hold on Jesus. Why is it important that death could not hold on to Jesus? How does this give you hope?

Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-9. Paul tells the Corinthians about all those who saw Jesus after his resurrection in order to encourage their belief. Does this account strengthen your faith in the resurrection? Why?
