Sunday, April 15th

Sermon Notes:

Read Acts 4:23-31. Faced with persecution, the early Christians prayed for boldness and for God to heal and perform signs and wonders. God answered their prayers by sending the Holy Spirit. Pray for God to empower you with boldness to live the life to which you are called. *Prayer focus: Pray for God's Spirit to fill our church so that, through words and deeds, we might declare the word of God with boldness.*

Monday, April 16th

Read Acts 4:32-35. The first church shared their possessions in order that the rest of the church would benefit. What will you share in order to protect vulnerable children and women from malaria?

Prayer focus: Pray for Pastor Andrew and his family, that they would have wisdom in utilizing their resources to care for malaria victims.

Tuesday, April 17th

Read Mark 16:14-18. After Jesus' resurrection, he sent his followers to declare the good news to the whole world with signs following. Are you an agent of God's good news? What signs are evidence? *Prayer focus: Pray for church plants, Journey UMC and the Stand UMC, that they would see signs of protection and healing.*

Wednesday, April 18th

Read Psalm 133. The Lord has ordained blessing on the people of God when they are united. Imagine what God can do when we stand in unity with United Methodists throughout the world to combat malaria. *Prayer focus: Pray for the United Methodist General Conference that every delegate would be able to hear from God and encounter God.*

Thursday, April 19th

Read Isaiah 53:1-6. Jesus' suffering opened the way for us to experience healing and alleviation from our suffering. How can you be a better agent of God's healing power? Pray for the end of malaria. *Prayer focus: Pray for Charis Storms that she would see evidence of God's healing power in Mongolia.*

Friday, April 20th

Read John 4:46-54. The officer believed when Jesus healed his son. Have you seen miracles? How have they brought you closer to God? Pray that God's healing power would draw more families to belief. *Prayer focus: Pray for the situation surrounding the death of Trayvon Martin, that healing, reconciliation, and justice would spring forth.*

Saturday, April 21st

Read Luke 18:15-17. Jesus identifies vulnerable children as key parts of his Kingdom. Pray for children throughout the world to know Jesus in their youth and to experience God's healing and grace today. *Prayer focus: Pray for the people of Japan, North Korea, South Korea, and Taiwan, that they would encounter the risen Christ.*
