# Sunday, April 22nd

Sermon Notes:

Read Acts 2:22-41. Why do you think that 3,000 people responded with faith after Peter preached this sermon? Was the message especially compelling? How do you respond when you hear the simple Good News of Jesus' death and resurrection? Prayer focus: Pray for God's Spirit to fill our church so that, we might respond to the Good News with faith, repentance, and renewed love.

Read 1 Corinthians 2:1-5. What is your faith based on? Have people used wise words to draw you to faith or have you encountered God? Talk with God about where you see (or don't see) God in your life. Prayer focus: Pray for Pastor Andrew and his family, that they would rely on the power of God and not persuasive words in ministry.	<b>Thursday, April 26th</b> Read Acts 7. Why did this crowd respond so differently from the crowd in Acts 2? What times in your life do you respond like the Acts 7 crowd?  Prayer focus: Pray for Charis Storms that she would be filled with the faith and hope of the Good News.
Tuesday, April 24th  Read 1 John 1. Do you recognize the sin in your life? Ask God to search you and confess your sins to God as God reveals them to you.  Trust that God forgives you as you confess!  Prayer focus: Pray for church plants, Journey UMC and the Stand UMC, that they would turn to God in the midst of their sinfulness.	Friday, April 27th  Read Luke 19:1-10. Zacchaeus' faith and repentance were clear to  Jesus because of the costly ways that he repented from his greed. What acts accompany your repentance?  Prayer focus: Pray for the churches of Lunenburg County, that we would encounter God in life-changing ways.
Wednesday, April 25th  Read Matthew 3:1-11. Why was it important for the people to recognize their sinfulness in preparation for the ministry of Jesus? What does John's message say to you today?  Prayer focus: Pray for the United Methodist General Conference that every delegate would be able to hear from God and encounter God.	Saturday, April 28th  Read 1 Corinthians 6:9-20. How do you respond when you read this list? Do you live in such a way as to honor God in your body and how you live?  Prayer focus: Pray for the people of Djibouti an Somalia, that they would encounter the risen Christ and be transformed.
