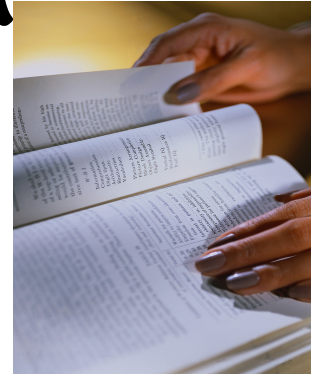
### Prayers for the church, nation, and world:

**Tuesday, April 27th**
