Read Acts 9:1-20. Put yourself in Ananias' situation. How would you feel about going to pray for Saul? We do not know if God spoke to Ananias in an audible voice or in his mind. How would you need to hear God in order to undertake this type of journey?

Monday, April 26th

Read Acts 4:1-31. How would you respond if the authorities ordered you not to speak about Jesus? Peter and John knew that they needed God's help to be bold, so they prayed for boldness. In what areas do you need God to help you to be a light for him? Ask God to help!

Tuesday, April 27th

Read Acts 8:26-40. Philip was constantly looking for ways that he could share the Good News and be a light to those he encountered. Are you looking for opportunities to be a light? How? Take time to ask God to put you in places where you can be used to touch others.

Wednesday, April 28th

Read Acts 27. Paul was being transported to Rome for trial when things started to go badly. Despite his arrest and the storm, Paul is able to reflect God to those around him. How do you shine God's light during your difficult times or in times when others are in trouble?

Thursday, April 29th

Read Matthew 5:13-16. Because you follow Jesus, you *are* the light of the world. Can people see the light of God in you? How do you put your light on a lampstand so others can see it?

Friday, April 30th

Read Psalm 23. We are invited to be sheep who listen to every word from our shepherd, God. How well do you listen for God's voice? Do you listen to God above the voices of other people and possessions?

Saturday, May 1st

Read 1 John 3:11-24. We love and share God's light primarily by our actions. What acts of love have you done this week for people beyond your close friends and family?

Sunday, May 2nd

We celebrate the resurrection every Sunday, so take time to prepare your heart. Offer this greeting to your family and speak it to yourself:

> "Christ is Risen!" "He is Risen Indeed!"
