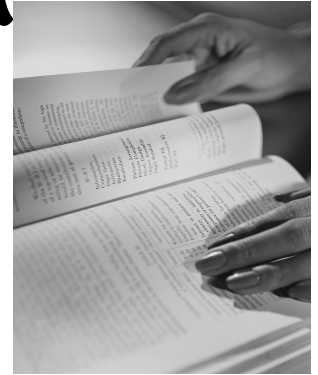
Prayers for the church, nation, and world:

Inviting you to daily time with God.

Every day the Transformation Journal will offer you a scripture passage and a question or two for reflection. Take a few minutes each day, and see what God has for you! The prayer list is also on the back, so please take time to pray for those we have lifted up on Sunday.

Sunday, May 16th

Sermon Notes:

Read Acts 1:1-11. Imagine yourself in the place of the first disciples. How would you feel at Jesus' departure? How would you feel about the commission that he gave you? Do you think that the Holy Spirit helps us to live out God's mission today? How?

Monday, May 17th

Read Ephesians 1:15-23. What does it mean, in practical terms, that Jesus is seated at the right hand of God in heavenly places? How does Jesus' position and reign impact the church? How should we honor Christ as the one seated at the right hand of God?

Tuesday, May 18th

Read John 16:7-15. Jesus promised that it is better for us to have the Holy Spirit in our lives than his physical presence. Do you feel like the Spirit is present in your life? How? Ask God to send the Holy Spirit to be more active in you.

Wednesday, May 19th

Read Acts 2:22-36. For Peter, the ascension was an essential piece of Jesus' story. Why is it so important that Jesus has been "exalted at the right hand of God?" Does your understanding of Jesus give an important spot to his exaltation? Why or why not?

Thursday, May 20th

Read John 14:15-26. The Holy Spirit should be our teacher. Are you open to being taught by the Holy Spirit? How? What has the Holy Spirit taught you?

Friday, May 21st

Read Revelation 5:11-14. Take time to enter into this heavenly worship scene. Imagine yourself as part of the picture and offer your praise to Jesus who is exalted on high!

Saturday, May 22nd

Read Revelation 7:9-12. Is it important that the multitude worshipping Jesus is made up of people from every nation, tribe, people, and language? What does it mean for Jesus to be Lord of all nations?

Sunday, May 23rd

As we gather for worship, prepare your heart by focusing on God and offering this prayer: "Living God, as we gather to worship you today, help me to encounter you, to truly worship you, to hear from you and to have my life changed by you. In Jesus' name, Amen."
