Sunday, May 27th

Sermon Notes:

Read Acts 1:1-10. How does Jesus' promise that we will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon us compare to your experience of the Holy Spirit in the church today? Do you think we would see more of the Spirit's power if we lived out the call to witness?

Prayer focus: Pray that God would call our church to a passionate witness for Jesus and that we would see the Spirit's power as we share.

Monday, May 28th

Read Acts 2. The first act of the Holy Spirit was to give the disciples the tools to share the Gospel in a powerful way with their hearers. Ask God to empower you to discover how to share the Gospel effectively. *Prayer focus: Pray for Pastor Andrew and his family, that they would share the Gospel with power born of the Spirit.*

Tuesday, May 29th

Read Matthew 26:47-75. How do these disciples compare with the group preaching boldly in Acts 2 (see yesterday)? In what ways has the Holy Spirit changed you?

Prayer focus: Pray for church plants, Journey UMC and the Stand UMC, that they would be transformed by the Holy Spirit.

Wednesday, May 30th

Read John 15:26-27. What is your personal mission in life? How well does your mission line up with the mission of the Spirit? Are you working together with the Spirit?

Prayer focus: Pray for the United Methodist Church, that we would be led by the Spirit and working together with the Spirit.

Thursday, May 31st

Read John 16:7-15. Do you believe Jesus that we are better off without him because the Holy Spirit is here? How have you seen the advantages of the Spirit's presence in your life? *Prayer focus: Pray for Charis Storms that she would be filled afresh with God's Spirit and trust in the Spirit's guidance.*

Friday, June 1st

Read Judges 16. How do you know that God's Spirit is present with you? Would you know if God left you? Talk with God about the New Testament promise that God will not leave us (Hebrews13:5). *Prayer focus: Pray for the churches of Lunenburg County, that we would be places where our community can encounter the Holy Spirit.*

Saturday, June 2nd

Read Romans 8:22-27. Take time to pray for the Gospel to go forth in our community. Allow the Spirit to pray through you in times when you don't have the words to pray.

Prayer focus: Pray for the people of Botswana and Zimbabwe, that they would encounter the Holy Spirit and live for God.
