Wednesday, June 6th Read Revelation 7:9-17. Imagine yourself in this diverse worshipping throng. How does it feel to worship next to people who look, sound, and smell different than you do? Prayer focus: Pray for the United Methodist Church, that we would be led by the Spirit and working together with the Spirit.	Saturday, June 9th Read 1 Corinthians 9:19-23.
