Prayers for the church, nation, and world:

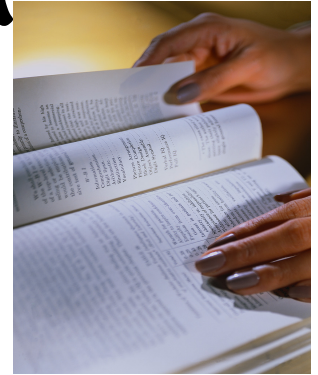
-For our churches, that we can determine the *labor of love* to which God is calling us

Transformation Journal

June 6, 2010



Inviting you to daily time with God.

Each day the Transformation Journal will offer you a scripture passage and a question or two for reflection. Take a few minutes each day, and see what God has for you! The prayer list is also on the back, so please take time to pray for those we have lifted up on Sunday.

Sunday, June 6th

Sermon Notes:

Read Luke 3:1-6. In this passage, John the Baptist is describing God's call on his life to prepare the way of the Lord. Does the call of God to John match God's call to you? If so, how? If not, what is God calling you to live for?

Monday, June 7th

Read Habakkuk 1:12-2:3. Habakkuk questions God and then waits diligently for God to answer and, as a result, is prepared to hear from God. What can you learn from this passage? Are you as committed to hearing from God as a watchman is to protecting a city?

Tuesday, June 8th

Read Acts 8:26-40. How was Phillip able to prepare the way for God to encounter the Ethiopian? Phillip was led by the Holy Spirit to this conversation. How do you envision the Spirit leading Phillip? Are you listening to hear the Spirit leading you in this way?

Wednesday, June 9th

Read Acts 17:10-15. These men and women were prepared to encounter God when Paul arrived because they looked to scripture to discover truth. How can scripture help you to be prepared? Do you spend enough time in scripture for it to help you see God?

Thursday, June 10th

Read Malachi 3:1-4. The process of refining is slow and hard but yields great results. Are you willing for God to refine you? Talk with God about areas in your life that you know need refining.

Friday, June 11th

Read Isaiah 40:3-5. How does preparing the way lead to people seeing the glory of God? What can you do to prepare the way for the people around you to encounter God?

Saturday, June 12th

Read 2 Kings 4:1-7. What would have happened to this widow if she had not acted in faith and gathered the jars? Are there areas of your life where God is waiting for you to prepare before God blesses you?

Sunday, June 13th

As you get ready for worship today, take time to prepare your heart to see God. Offer this prayer: **“Living God, as we gather to worship you today, help me to encounter you, to truly worship you, to hear from you and to have my life changed by you. In Jesus’ name, Amen.”**
