Sermon Notes:

Read Acts 2:1-13. The day of Pentecost has come to represent the day the empowering presence of the Holy Spirit came to dramatically transform the church. Is your life radically changed by the Spirit? Ask God to make you more responsive to the Spirit's work in your life!

Monday, June 13th
Read Acts 2:14-21. The disciples appeared to be drunk because of their transformation—from cowering to boldness, quietness to speaking in
different languages. What does it look like when the Spirit empowers
you and breaks you free from inhibitions to live radically for God?
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Tuesday, June 14th
Read Psalm 104:24-35. God's Spirit has been the life-giving presence
of God on earth. Look around you at the growth this season and know
that God's Spirit is still at work. Praise God for caring for creation and
sustaining our lives through new growth!
Wednesday, June 15th
Read I Corinthians 12:3-11. The Holy Spirit gifts each person uniquely
to the benefit of the whole church. Are you using the gifts the Spirit
has given you to build up your brothers and sister in the faith? How can
you be intentional in fulfilling God's desires for you in our community?

Thursday, June 16th

Read I Corinthians 12:12-13. The Spirit has made us one body; each dependent on the others. How are you dependent on those around you so grow as a disciple? How can you encourage others to use their gifts?
Friday, June 17th
Read John 7:37-39. Jesus describes the Spirit as living water of which we are to partake. Do you rely on the Spirit's work in your life like the numan body relies on water? Are you dehydrated? Come and drink!
Saturday, June 18th
Read John 16:12-15. The Spirit leads us to all truth. Are you seeking God's truth? If so, be encouraged because God wants you to know truth! If not, examine your heart to see if you truly want to follow God.
Sunday, June 19th

As we gather for worship, prepare your heart by focusing on God and offering this prayer: "Living God, as we gather to worship you today, help me to encounter you, to truly worship you, to hear from you and to have my life changed by you. In Jesus' name, Amen."
