Sunday, July 17th

Every day the Transformation Journal will offer you a scripture passage and a question or two for reflection. Take a few minutes each day, and see what God has for you! The prayer list is also on the back, so please take time to pray for those we have lifted up on Sunday.

Sermon Notes: Read Ezekiel 37:1-13. How does it feel to know that there is no such thing as being too dry to be renewed by God's Spirit? How do you feel knowing that even when you lose hope, God is still ready to give you more of the Holy Spirit? Prayer focus: Pray for the United Methodist Church as a whole that we would be filled afresh with God's Spirit.

Monday, July 18th Read Acts 1. The disciples follow Jesus' instruction to wait for the Spirit by focusing their time in prayer. Do you believe that you need the Holy Spirit? Are you willing to commit to asking God for more? Prayer focus: Pray for Charis Storms and her work in Mongolia, that she might constantly be receiving more of the Holy Spirit in her life.	Thursday, July 21st Read Luke 3:21-22. Luke tells us that the Holy Spirit came upon Jesus while he was praying after his baptism. What can we learn by knowing the even Jesus received the Spirit through prayer? Prayer focus: Pray for our church, that we would be pray-ers and that God would pour out the Holy Spirit on us in powerful ways.
Tuesday, July 19th Read Luke 11:9-13. Jesus assures us that God will give the Holy Spirit to those who commit to asking for the Spirit. Take some time to pray for the Spirit in your life. Prayer focus: Pray for more of the Holy Spirit in the new church plants in our area: The Stand UMC (Fort Lee) and Journey UMC (Amelia).	Friday, July 22nd Read Isaiah 55. God is inviting you to come and receive! Take time to draw near to God today through prayer, song, art, journaling, walking in nature or whatever other activity helps you to connect with God. Prayer focus: Pray for leaders, especially the president and members of Congress, that they would hear God's invitation and respond.
Wednesday, July 20th Read Acts 2:1-13. When the Holy Spirit came on the day of Pentecost, there was no doubt that the Spirit was present. How does the Holy Spirit work in and through you? Prayer focus: Pray for Pastor Andrew and his family, that they might all receive more of the Spirit and be used fully by God.	Saturday, July 23rd Read John 4:1-42. What can we learn about the gift of living water from Jesus' encounter with the woman at the well? Have you asked Jesus to give you living water/the Spirit (John 7:37-39)? Prayer focus: Pray for the people of Belize, Guatemala, Honduras and Mexico, that they might have their physical and spiritual needs met
