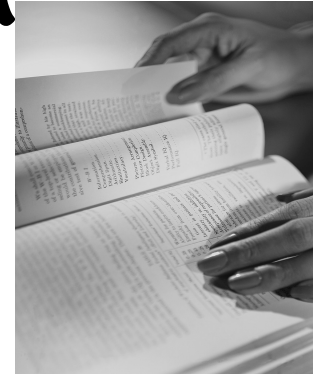
### Prayers for the church, nation, and world:

### **Sunday, October 31st**

Sermon Notes:

Read Luke 19:1-10. Zacchaeus encounters Jesus and changes how he acts by restoring what he had stolen and giving to the poor. How has encountering Jesus changed you? Is there anything that you need to restore?

**Monday, November 1st**

Read Psalm 51. Pray through this psalm a few times. As you pray through the psalm, consider what God is asking you to repent from. Take the time to ask for forgiveness and ask God to help you live differently.

**Tuesday, November 2nd**

Read Luke 3:8-13. The call to bear fruits worthy of repentance is a call to live out repentance in day-to-day life, not just to say “sorry” and continue to live the same ways. Think about one area of your life where you need to bear fruit worth of repentance.

**Wednesday, November 3rd**

Read John 4:1-42. What led you to believe that Jesus is the Savior of the world? What are one or two ways that you can share your story of Jesus’ involvement in your life like this woman? Remember, the townsfolk came to believe because they got to know Jesus themselves!
