Sermon Notes:

Monday, November 28th

Read Matthew 1:1-17. Think about each of these generations looking to see the coming of Jesus that is a reality for us today. Thank God for the joy available to us as people who have the chance to know Christ! *Prayer focus: Pray for Pastor Andrew and his family, that they might be filled with the joy of Christ's birth!*

Thursday, December 1st

Read Luke 2:36-38. Envision living as Anna did with all of your energy and focus on God. How would you feel about seeing the baby Jesus? How can you learn from Anna?

Prayer focus: Pray for Charis Storms that she would grow in her devotion to Jesus and her joy at seeing Christ.

Tuesday, November 29th

Read Luke 2:25-35. Imagine yourself as Simeon. How would you feel when you finally see the Christ child? Can you imagine living your entire life in anticipation of something God has told you? *Prayer focus: Pray for church plants, Journey UMC and the Stand UMC, to live in faith looking for God to work in their midst.*

Wednesday, November 30th

Read Hebrews 11:13-16. What you seek and long for says a lot about who you are. What are you longing for? Ask God to give you godly passions!

Prayer focus: Pray for the worldwide church, that we would be filled with a passion to see the things of God

Friday, December 2nd

Read John 17:13. Jesus prays that we would have his joy made complete in us. Do you think of Jesus as a joy-filled person? Do you have Jesus' joy in you?

Prayer focus: Pray for the United Methodist Church, that we would reflect the joy of Christ to a world in need of joy.

Saturday, December 3rd

Read Hebrews 1:8-9. God anointed Jesus with joy "far above his companions." How does that impact your understanding of Jesus' prayer that we would have his joy (see yesterday's reading)? *Prayer focus: Pray that the people of Liberia and Sierra Leone would know the joy of Christmas this year.*
