Sunday, December 4th

Sermon Notes:

Read Isaiah 40. Are you able to hear God speaking words of comfort and consolation to you today? In the midst of that comfort, can you hear God declaring that people are grass that will wither, so we need to find our Joy and Hope in God?

Prayer focus: Pray for our church, that we will be filled with joy and hope as we move through the season of Advent.

Monday, December 5th

Read Mark 1:1-8. The way for Jesus' coming was prepared by the call to repentance. Repentance recognizes our sinfulness, our desire to change, and God's desire to forgive. How do you need to repent? *Prayer focus: Pray for Pastor Andrew and his family, that they would prepare for Christ's coming through repentance.*

Thursday, December 8th

Read Ezekiel 18:20-24. God's desire is that all people would turn to God. Talk with God about people you know have yet to embrace Joy. Ask God to be working in their hearts and lives.

Prayer focus: Pray for Charis Storms that she would be able to point the people around her towards the Joy of God's love.

Tuesday, December oth

Read 2 Peter 3:8-15. How has God been patient with you in giving you time to come to repentance? Are there areas of your life that you have needed to repent of for a long time? Talk with God about them. *Prayer focus: Pray for church plants, Journey UMC and the Stand UMC, to be God's tools for drawing people to repentance.*

Wednesday, December 7th

Read Romans 2:1-4. Do you think of God as being kind? Why or why not? Do you represent the kindness of God to those around you? How has the kindness of God led you to repentance?

Prayer focus: Pray for the worldwide church, that we would recognize the kindness of God and live in response to God's kindness.

Friday, December 9th

Read 1 Timothy 1:12-17. Paul's recognition of his sinfulness and God's grace at work in him helped him to embrace the Joy of salvation and new life. Do you see your sinfulness?

Prayer focus: Pray for the United Methodist Church, that we recognize our sinfulness, repent, and be the church God is calling us to be.

Saturday, December 10th

Read Revelation 22:12. Read through this verse several times and ask God what invitation God offers you. Are you willing to embrace Joy and come to God?

Prayer focus: Pray that the people of Cape Verde, Gambia, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, and Senegal would know the joy of Christmas this year.
