Sermon Notes:

Read Luke 1:26-45. Imagine yourself in Mary's position: an angel appears to you with an outrageous story about what God is going to do in your life. How would you respond? Would you be able to say "let it be according to your word?" What can we learn from Mary? Prayer focus: Pray that our church will be guided by the word of God to be the church that God wants us to be

Monday, December 19th

Read Luke 1:46-55. Read through Mary's song and notice why God chose Mary. Does God see humility in you? What value do you give humility in your life? How can you practice humility?

Prayer focus: Pray for Pastor Andrew and his family, that they would be filled with Godly humility.

Tuesday, December 20th

Read Matthew 1:18-24. Envision yourself in Joseph's position engaged to a woman who you discover to be pregnant. How do you react? Would a dream with an angel change your plans? *Prayer focus: Pray for church plants, Journey UMC and the Stand UMC, to be those who proclaim the Good News of great Joy.*

Wednesday, December 21st

Read Isaiah 9:2-7. How has Jesus brought light into your life? What areas of your life are still in darkness that need to be illuminated by Christ's light?

Prayer focus: Pray for the worldwide church, that we would be powerful witnesses of the Joy of Christmas to those around us.

Thursday, December 22nd

Read John 1:1-18. This is John's version of the Christmas story! Why did God send Jesus to the earth? Read the passage again and focus in on whatever section catches your eye. Why do those verses matter? *Prayer focus: Pray for Charis Storms that she would be filled with the Joy of Christmas and share that Joy with others.*

Friday, December 23rd

Read Luke 2:1-20. In your mind's eye, imagine this story unfolding with you in the story. What do you hear? What do you see? What do you smell? How are Mary and Joseph reacting to the situation? *Prayer focus: Pray for the people of Syria as the country continues in a time of unrest as the government arrests and kills protestors.*

Saturday, December 24th

Read Psalm 96. As you celebrate Christmas Eve today and prepare for Christmas Day, take time to read this psalm a few times and praise God for sending Jesus to live among us.

Prayer focus: Pray that the people of Ghana and Nigeria would know the joy of Christmas this year.
